It's the final tax return system. If there is an excess or shortage in the income tax (calculated from the annual income earned from January 1 through December 31) of the previous year, adjustments will be made in the following year.

The tax reports must be filed to the regional taxation office between the due date,

February 18 (Monday) and March 15 (Friday). Application forms will be accepted at Parti Seto 5F.
